



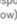
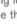




EXIT SCAN MODE

Press  or  to highlight Exit Scan mode, then press  to exit and return to the Scanned Image mode. The last scanned photo will not be saved in the internal memory.

SELECT A STORAGE DEVICE

This photo frame can play back content from internal and external memory devices such as USB flash drives, and memory cards (MMC, SD, MS/MS pro, CF type I, and xD cards) typically used with digital cameras. More than one external memory device can be inserted at the same time. However, the photo frame can only select one memory device at a time for playback of its content.

1. Power on the unit. The Device Select menu will appear on the screen.
2. When a memory device is inserted, its corresponding icon will light up (see below). Use the , , , and  buttons to highlight the desired storage device, then press OK/ to enter.
3. After selecting a memory device, the Main Menu will appear on the screen (see to the right).

I must say this was not the easiest feat since most of the file formats listed in the manual AVI, MP4, MOV did NOT work on the frame. I tried playing the videos on my OTHER Brookstone digital frame, and the videos were NOT working on that frame either. I ended up Googling and found nothing of use on their website or in the manual. Finally, after some trial and error on my Mac, I ended up converting the video to MPG format using PRISM and there was finally success. The video was about 80 MB in size and was about 30 seconds long. If you are tech-savvy and can edit videos you will be ok, if not, I would pass. I was able to restart it after several tries of one thing or another, but about 3 months ago it really slowed down but was able to get it going again. I could not clear it, turn it off, or even get it to work. The instructions in the manual are pathetic. I went to the Brookstone store yesterday and the clerk was absolutely helpless. Not sure what she was doing there. No wonder Brookstone is closing some of their stores; their employees are useless and very unknowledgeable of their store merchandise. Save your money folks. This product is fun, but not worth it at all. The video function doesn't work no matter what file type I try and how I adjust the size of the file. I can get images on it just fine and even music but no videos. I guess that's what it is. Just a digital picture frame with the option of music. Meh. Next time I will pony up and pay more for a better product not from Brookstone. Oh well, live and learn. When I accessed the internal disk, there is less than 500 GB of memory.
